LEADERSHIP FOR AREA GOVERNORS

- * Make a commitment to serve your District for one year
- * Strive to achieve Area goals in line with the 4 Critical Success Factors of the District
- * Visit each Club in your Area a minimum of 2 times per year
- * Complete Area Governor's Visitation Form for each Club in your Area and submit to the District Governor by October 31 and April 30
- * Attend Executive Committee meetings regularly – you are now a member of the Executive Council of the District
- * Attend the District Officer's Training sessions
- * Promote the Distinguished Club Program within each Club in your Area
- * Assist your Clubs in developing their Club Success Plan for the year
- * Participate in Club Officer Training programs
- * Organize and conduct Area Speech Contests 2 times per year
- * Assist your Area Clubs with fulfilling their administrative duties
- * Install Club Officers and educate the membership on servant leadership
- * Encourage membership campaigns and assist with Club rescue
- * Attend TLI, Spring and Fall Conferences, and promote District events
- * Communicate monthly with your Clubs
- * Bring new ideas and new information to your Clubs in a timely manner
- * Promote inter-club activities and share new ideas with all
- * Encourage future leaders to shadow as your assistant
- * Delegate, communicate, encourage, and inspire others
- * Seek help when needed from the Division Governor and Sr. Team
- * Be accountable, be open to new ideas and serve with a passion!
- * Have fun and always be positive!

- * Attend the District Officer's Training sessions
- * Serve as the leader of your Division and communicate with your Area Governors regularly
- * Provide motivation, guidance and supervision to Area Governors
- * Motivate Area Governors to achieve personal goals for the collective good
- * Participate in and support District-sponsored training events
- * Ensure a net gain of one or more Clubs within your Division
- * Work with the Lt Governor – Marketing to build new clubs in Division
- * Work with your Area Governors to re-build current Clubs to charter strength
- * Plan, organize and conduct Division Speech Contests 2 times per year
- * Attend TLI, Spring and Fall Conferences and promote District events
- * Delegate, communicate, encourage and inspire others
- * Be accountable, be open to new ideas and serve with passion!
